



Fig. S1. Effects of sealed ovipositors on behavioral activity. (A) Adult female with ovipositor sealed by white nail polish (arrowhead). Bar, 1 mm. (B) Illustration of a container for observing locomotor activity on a white LED light. (C) Behavioral activity recorded in three experiments (Exp.1–3). Box plot represents the distribution of the moving distance of control and sealed-ovipositor groups. Each open circle indicates the value of one female. ns indicates no significant difference (Wilcoxon rank sum test).
