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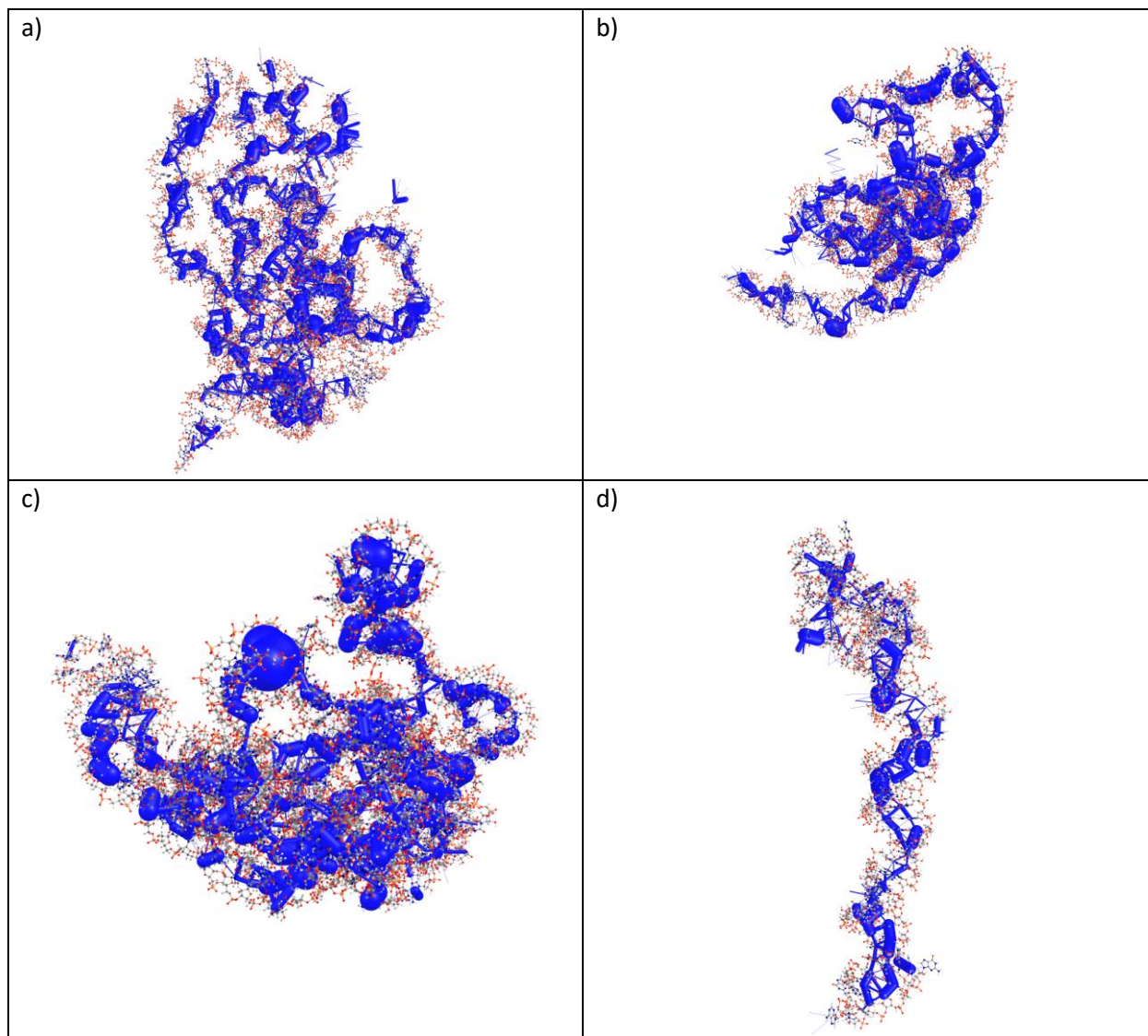


Fig. S1. Charge transfer integrals within 5' (a), central (b). 3' major (c) and 3' minor (d) domains of SSU

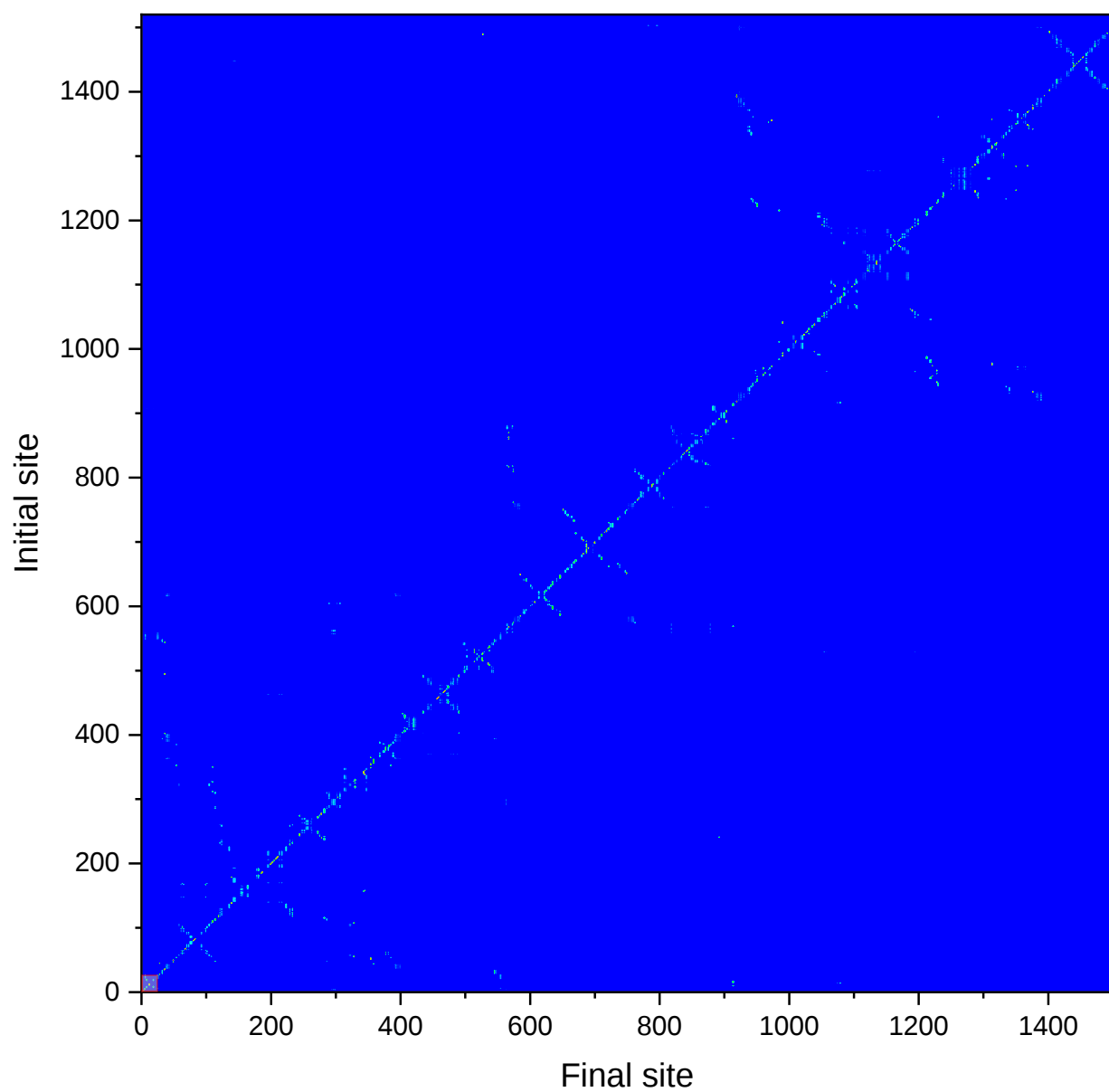


Fig. S2. Transition probabilities map for finding a hole placed at a given initial site at a given final site within SSU.

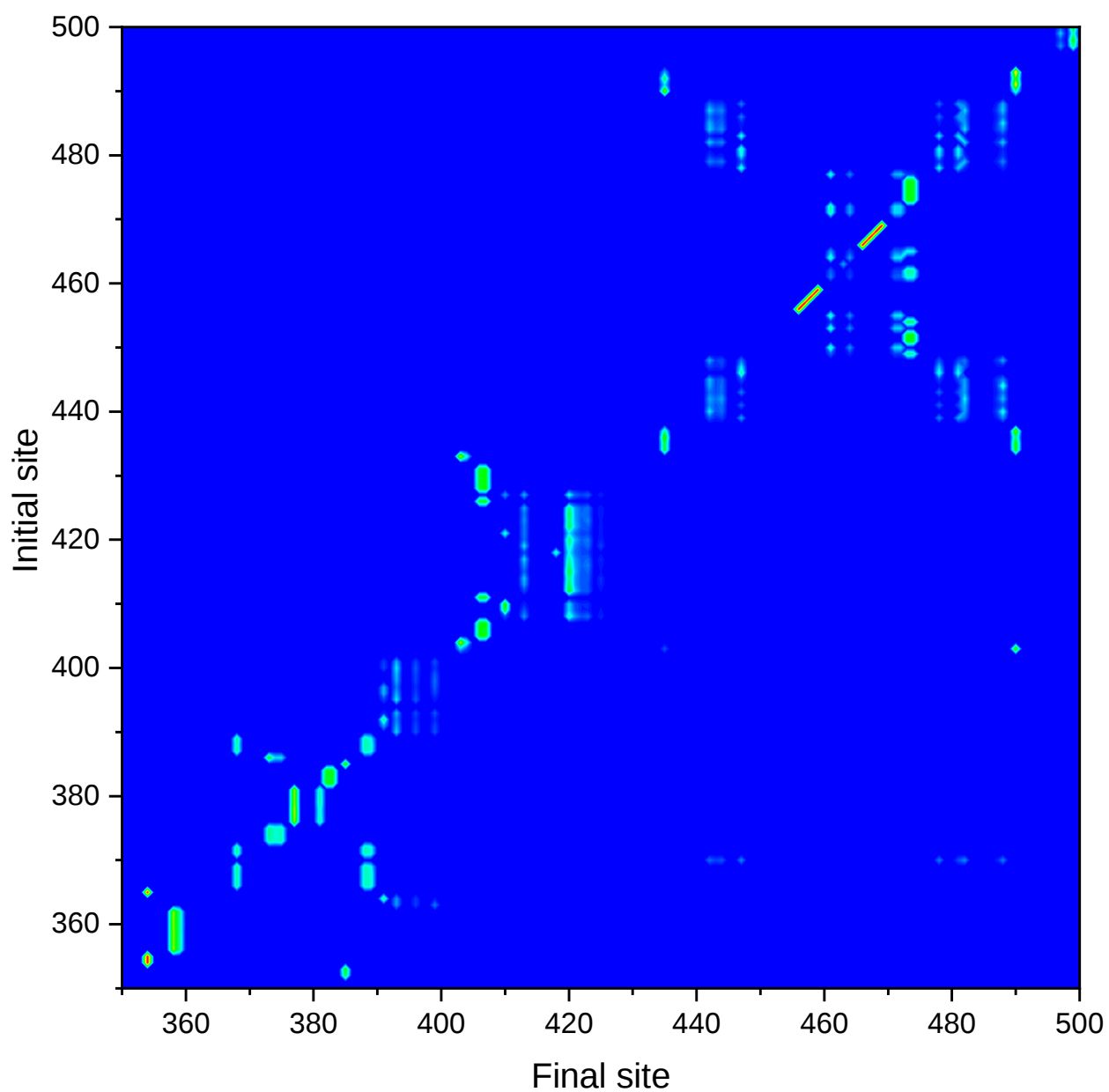


Fig. S3. Transition probabilities map for finding a hole placed at a given initial site at a given final site, in the vicinity of G424.
